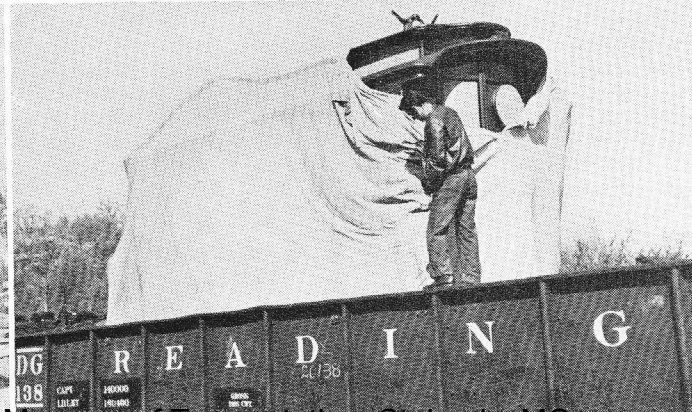
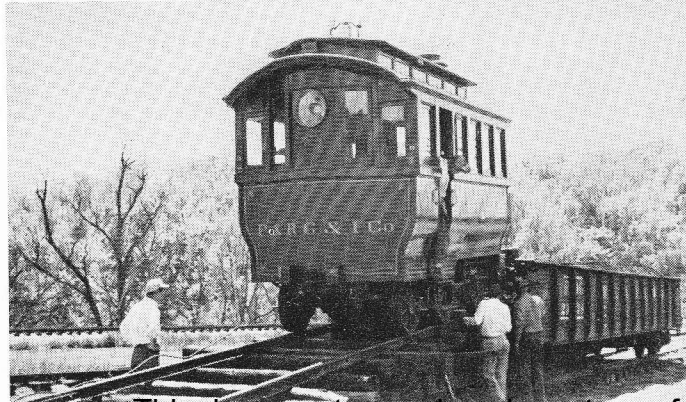
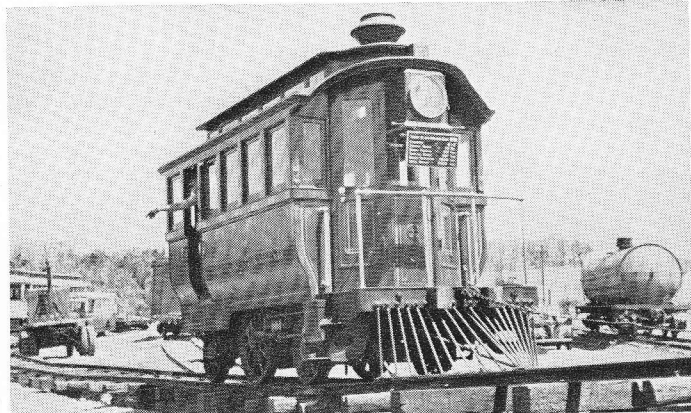
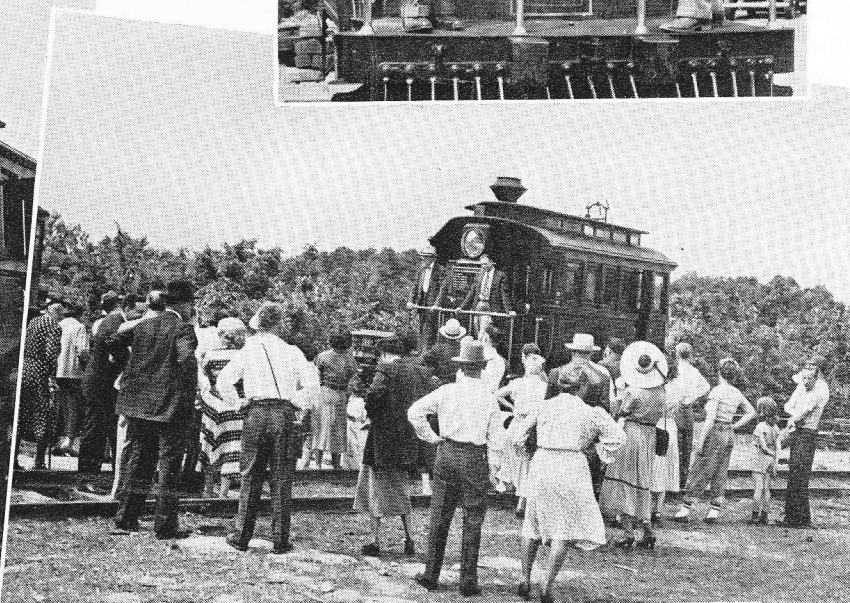
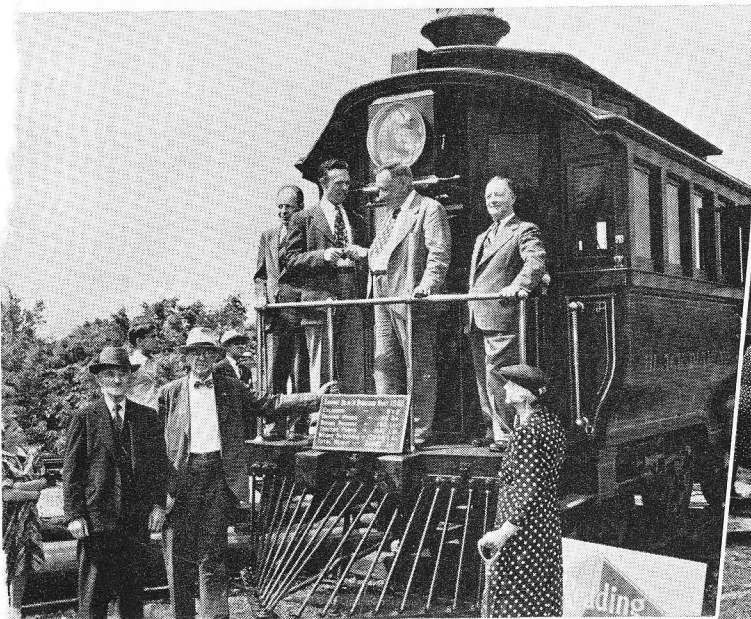


# "Black Diamond" Now a Museum Piece
